(Horse show classes # 10,12,14 will have a modified pattern and stop at center. Classes will be posted on Facebook & the board at the show)

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Camping Plug Ins \$30 +GST/Night
- Video fees are as follows.
  - \$47.25 – Derby (GST Included)
  - \$21 – Horse Show Classes (Per day, GST Included)

#### **Payment can be made by:**

- E transfers will be taken up until June 14, 2023 prior to the show starting once invoice is received



- **All fees must be paid by Saturday June 17, 2023 by 2:00 pm.**
- If competing in Derby, or NRCHA approved classes, owners and riders must have NRCHA and NARCHC memberships. If competing only in NARCHC approved classes, owner and rider must have NARCHC memberships.
- Anyone helping warm up horses or riding in the arena **MUST** be wearing full western attire and have a current NARCHC membership
- Membership and Non Pro Declaration (if applicable) must be signed and sent in prior to showing.
- NARCHC rules apply to all NARCHC approved classes \ NRCHA rules apply to all NRCHA approved classes; please refer to the NRCHA/NARCHC rulebook
- An owner may enter multiple horses, a rider may compete on multiple horses, but a horse may only be entered once in each division.
- The NARCHC reserves the right to accept or reject any entry. All board decisions are final.
- The NARCHC reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the event without notice or liability. In the event of a cancellation, all entry fees paid to date will be refunded. Any interest accrued on the entries is the property of NARCHC.
- All entries must include a copy of the horse's registration papers, NRCHA grade competition license, or a written veterinary age authentication. Failure to include any of the above will constitute an incomplete entry.
- These rules and conditions may change to better enhance the show. Any changes will be decided and presented by the NARCHC Board of Directors &/or Committee on behalf of the NARCHC Board of Directors.
- Entry confirmation will be sent out and posted once all entries have been received.

**\* By entry submission you are acknowledging that you and/or your horse meet the criteria to compete in selected classes. Riders are responsible to check and confirm entry before they compete. \***

## **STALLS**

- Stalls can be moved in on June 15, 2023 after 4:00 pm. **Arena will be open from 5-9 pm**
- Contestants are responsible to check in with the barn office to get stalls unlocked.
- Stalls include two bags of shavings; bags of shavings can be purchased on site for \$10/bag
- **Stalls are \$110 for the weekend**



## Practice Works

- Pricing is as follows; \$75/ Fence, \$115/ Cutting (2 cows)
- **June 16, 2023 Pending entry numbers practice works will commence after all Derby/Horse show classes are complete for the day**

## Bar TT Cow Horse DERBY

1. **Derby entries will be accepted until June 3, 2023.** Late entries will be accepted with an additional two hundred dollars (\$200.00) late fee up to cattle order date.
  - a. All entries must include a copy of the horse's registration papers, NRCHA grade competition license, or a written veterinary age authentication. Failure to include any of the above will constitute an incomplete entry.
  - b. Competitors must enter online @ <https://narchc.com/news-events/>
2. Horses of any breed can compete if they meet the NRCHA requirements.
3. A **Derby** entry is open to any 4 or 5-year-old horse (6-year old's may be shown in the Non Pro Boxing but must be shown in a Snaffle). An entry consists of 3 events; Herd work, Reined work, and Fence work, which each horse must compete in. Horses must be shown in either a hackamore or snaffle bit that meets the requirements set forth in the NRCHA Rulebook.
4. Any non pro showing a grade horse, must provide proof of ownership.
5. **Non pros cannot show under a transfer report. The registration must be transferred to the competitor prior to the show.**
6. **\$125.00 Cross entry discount applies when entering Level 1 Non Pro Derby / Non-Pro Derby.**
7. **Open/Limited Open Derby will be based on a 70% / 30% payout**

## HORSE SHOW

1. Horse show entries will be accepted until June 3, 2023. Late entries will be accepted with an additional fifty dollar (\$50.00) late fee up to cattle order date.
  - a. Competitors must enter online @ <https://narchc.com/news-events/>
  - b. All entries must include a copy of the horse's registration papers, NRCHA grade competition license, or a written veterinary age authentication. Failure to include any of the above will constitute an incomplete entry.
2. For classes that are NRCHA approved, competitor can choose to enter NARCHC class, NRCHA class, or both classes. **Fees dependent on entered classes.**
  - a. To enter an NRCHA approved class rider/owner must have a current 2023 NARCHC and NRCHA membership.
  - b. To enter an NARCHC approved class rider/owner must have a current 2023 NARCHC membership.



- c. NRCHA classes run concurrently within NARCHC classes.
  - d. Payout based on each Association's payout schedule.
3. Classes that run concurrently are as follows:
  - a. Open/Intermediate/Ltd. Open Bridle
  - b. Non Pro/Intermediate/Level 1
  - c. Non Pro/Select Non Pro Bridle
  - d. Open/Intermediate/Ltd. Open Hackamore
  - e. Intermediate Non Pro Boxing/Non-Pro Boxing/ Select Non Pro Boxing /Limited Non Pro Boxing
  - f. Youth Boxing /Youth Boxing 13 & under
- 4. Sunday NRCHA horse show classes will be jackpot only, no added money.**

## **SCRATCHES**

If an entry is scratched before June 13, 2023, entrant will not be responsible for entry and any prepaid fees will be refunded. After June 13, 2023, entrant will be charged add back and half of the office/cattle charge. Any scratches after June 15, 2023 all fees are due and payable unless vet certificate is provided.

## **SUBSTITUTIONS**

1. Rider substitutions must be brought forth to show secretary with legitimate reasoning, board will decide if substitution is allowed.
2. Horse substitutions must be brought forth to show secretary with a copy of the new horse's papers and a new entry form, board will decide if substitution is allowed.
